The Sohei, warrior monk's, Kempo was very comprehensive, since they never knew what kind of battle they might find themselves involved in. It was also called Kara-Te, or Chinese Hand. The long ones were mostly used on horseback, while foot soldiers and others not mounted used the short weapons.
