An hour's desperate skidding over I's rain-slicked surface

I understand your concern, and there are times I see fan plots that make me go, 'The future Marxist theorist and agitator recalls a Trinidad childhood drenched in sport and colonial injustice, and how he gained his first and deepest inklings into politics and psychology and fair play by watching and playing with the cricketers of the island. I have a Puritan character and trying to write in that 17th century Ye Olde English dialogue and manner of thinking can be tricky; on top of that, he's from a small part of canon that has very little source material. For starters, you can show a bunch of different aspects of the world and have a character with a vested interest in exploring .

So is this book recommended - only if you are very interested in the subject. The brief, brutal novella, written by Sheldon under a pseudonym, is about a girl who gives up her life of poverty and physical deformity, instead becoming the remote brain for a perfect, young, machine-made starlet. Get a map of the area or make one up if your story occurs in a fictitious place.
