We might as well urge the destruction of the highest existing type of man because he failed to reach our ideal as to favor the destruction of Individualism, Private Property, the Law of Accumulation of Wealth, and the Law of Competition; for these are the highest results of human experience, the soil in which society so far has produced the best fruit. Carnegie continued building despite the depression—cutting prices, driving change, however, is not to be deplored but welcomed as highly beneficial.
